


# Connecting with the benefice via Facebook

Go to [www.facebook.com](http://www.facebook.com)




Fill in your

details under "Create new account" and click the green "Sign up button"



When you have finished, click the "Home" button to the top right of the screen




## Connecting to the St Guthlac's Church Page

Search "St Guthlac's Church, Knighton" in the search box to the top left of the screen...




Then, click on the "St

Guthlac's Church, Knighton" blue link - This will open the Page.




Please press the "Like" button and the "Follow" button (red arrows below)
